 - Jeremiah 23:5-6
 - Micah 4:6-7
 - Zechariah 9:9-10

2. What is the threat of being a 'moment' Christian? What temptations do you face when your faith is only based on a moment?
3. What does it mean to be a 'movement' Christian? How does Jesus invite us into the movement?
4. What is the cost of following Jesus? What has following Jesus cost you? (Hint- think of things you have to give up, discipline to fight temptation, things you have left behind)
5. Why is it important to know that Jesus is coming back? How does that change the way we follow Jesus?
6. **Dig Deeper**—Are you prepared to share the good news of Jesus to a nonbeliever? What would you say?
